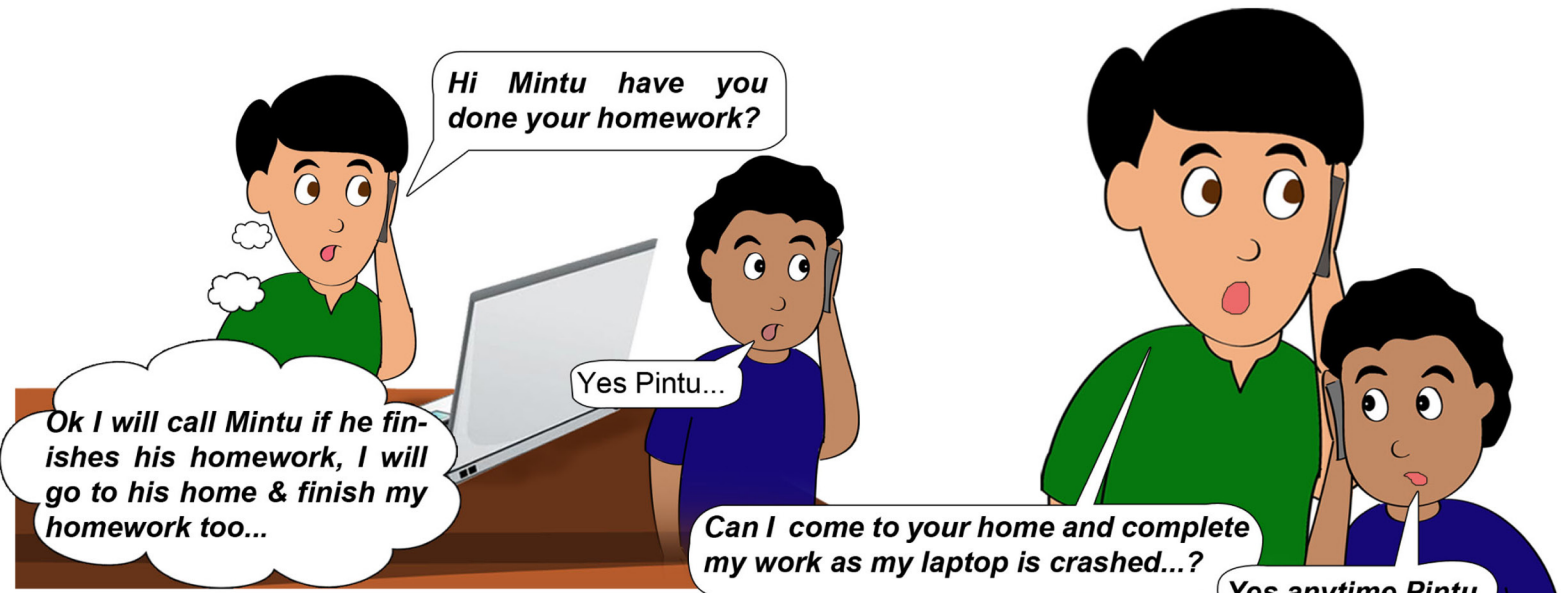


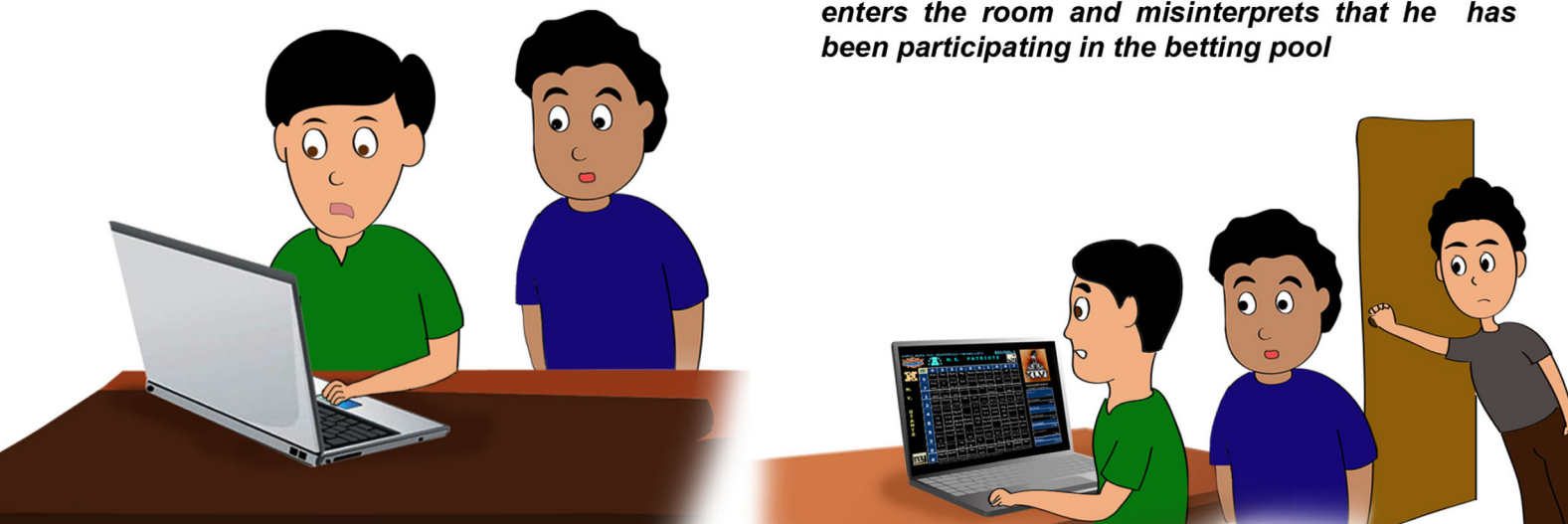

Immediately when the link opened, his friend enters the room and misinterprets that he has been participating in the betting pool



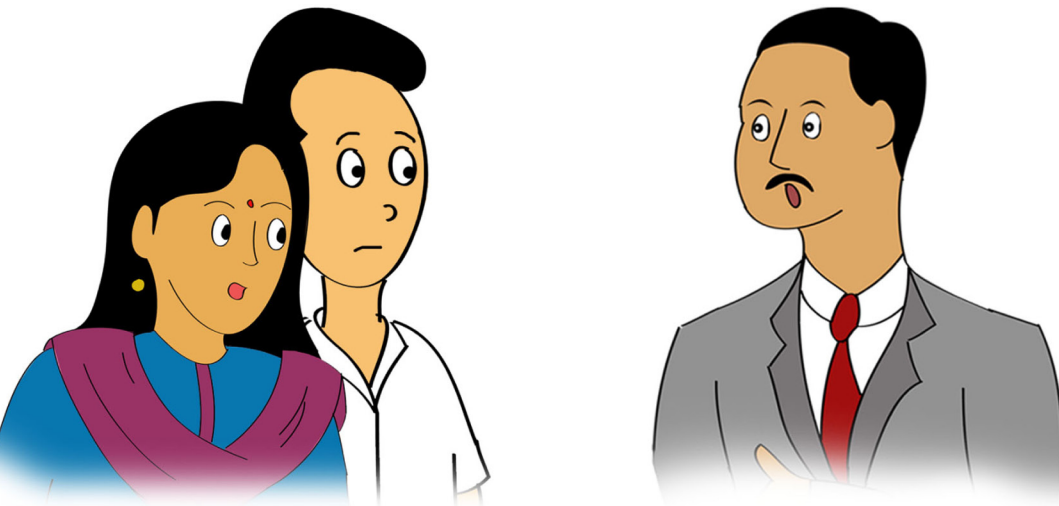
He spreads this news to his school friends, everyone and it finally reached the teachers

- 4. Teens can guess and find passwords, or even find a way to disable the program or get around it if they have the computer knowledge.*
- 5. Although these programs can be helpful in preventing accidental or unwanted exposure to the things you are filtering out; remember that you can't be with them 24 hours a day, seven days a week.*
